Subject: Extensive Flooding in Myanmar

I wish to convey our heartfelt sympathy for the loss of lives, the displacement of families and the widespread damages to property, agriculture as well as infrastructure caused by extensive flooding in Myanmar affecting 9 states and regions of Kayin, Mon, Rakhine and Shan, Tanintharyi, Bago, Magway, Ayeyarwady, Sagaing region and Nay Pyi Taw Union Territory.

I also wish to commend the Government of Myanmar for the immediate evacuation as well as search and rescue measures to alleviate the suffering of the people in affected states and regions. It is with great concern that the impact of such catastrophe has affected an increasing number of the population, requiring immediate provision of temporary shelters and aid assistance to the communities.
