THE SEVENTEENTH ASEAN AND JAPAN TRANSPORT MINISTERS MEETING (17th ATM+Japan) 15 November 2019, Ha Noi, Viet Nam

JOINT MINISTERIAL STATEMENT

1. The 17th ASEAN and Japan Transport Ministers Meeting (17th ATM+Japan) was held on 15th November 2019 in Ha Noi, Viet Nam. The Meeting was co-chaired by H.E. Mr. Nguyen Van The, Minister of Transport of Viet Nam and H.E. Mr. MINORIKAWA Nobuhide, State Minister of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism of Japan. The Meeting was preceded by the 18th ASEAN and Japan Senior Transport Officials Meeting (18th STOM+Japan) held on 13th November 2019.

2. The ASEAN Ministers welcomed the announcement of Japan to support the various activities based on the Kuala Lumpur Transport Strategic Plan 2016-2025 in the areas of air transport, land transport, maritime transport, sustainable transport and transport facilitation through projects and activities under the ASEAN-Japan Transport Partnership (AJTP) in a comprehensive and sustained manner.

3. The Ministers noted with satisfaction the steady progress of 24 projects implemented based on the AJTP Work Plan for 2018-2019, under the Pakse Action Plan adopted at the 11th ATM+Japan in December 2013. The Ministers adopted the "ASEAN Green Ship Strategy" as a key deliverable under the AJTP Work Plan for 2018-2019.

4. The Ministers endorsed the AJTP Work Plan for 2019-2020 which would further enhance regional connectivity. The Ministers noted that the AJTP Work Plan for 2019-2020 included the five new initiatives: the "GNSS Implementation Plan Training in ASEAN (GIPTA)"¹, "Proof of Concept (PoC) on ICT Solutions for Overloaded Vehicle Control", "Joint Research on Bridge Maintenance for ASEAN Cross-Border Corridors", "Extension of VTS Operators Training", and "Improving Accessibility to Public Transport for People with Disabilities and the Elderly." The list of projects/activities contained in the AJTP Work Plan for 2019-2020 appears as <u>ANNEX</u> <u>1</u>.

5. The Ministers noted the progress in the 4th ASEAN-Japan Consultation on Regional Air Services Agreement (AJC-RASA) in September 2019 in Philippines. The Ministers agreed to task the AJC-RASA to work towards the successful conclusion of a more liberal and mutually beneficial ASEAN-Japan Air Services Agreement with a view to enhancing the air transport relationship between ASEAN and Japan.

6. The 18th ATM+Japan Meeting will be convened in Brunei Darussalam in 2020.
