



## THE SEVENTH ASEAN-INDIA MINISTERIAL MEETING ON AGRICULTURE AND FORESTRY (the 7<sup>TH</sup> AIMMAF) 26 October 2022

## JOINT PRESS STATEMENT

(Final)

- The Seventh ASEAN India Ministerial Meeting on Agriculture and Forestry was held virtually on 26 October 2022. The Meeting was co-chaired by H.E. Dr. Phet Phomphiphak, Minister of Agriculture and Forestry of Lao PDR and H.E Shri Narendra Singh Tomar, Minister for Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare of India.
- The Meeting noted the significant progress in the implementation of the ASEAN-India Strategic Partnership, through the implementation of various programmes and activities across the three ASEAN Community pillars, based on the current Plan of Action to Implement the ASEAN-India Partnership for Peace, Progress and Shared Prosperity (2021-2025), and welcomed the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of ASEAN-India relations.
- 3. The Meeting reaffirmed its commitment to ensuring ASEAN-India cooperation in agriculture and forestry, which substantially contributes to deepening the ASEAN-India Strategic Partnership and supports the ASEAN Community building efforts.
- 4. The Meeting reiterated its commitment to continue efforts to implement postpandemic recovery measures to address the unprecedented impact of the COVID-19 pandemic by ensuring the unimpeded flow of safe and nutritious agricultural produce in the ASEAN and India region.
- 5. The Meeting noted the progress made in the implementation of the Medium-Term Plan of Action for ASEAN-India Cooperation in Agriculture and Forestry (2021-2025), namely: i) outlining priorities and measures to deepen the cooperation in agriculture and forestry, particularly the priority projects relating to the ASEAN-India fellowship for higher education in agriculture, ii) exchange visits for farmers in ASEAN and India, iii) climate-smart agriculture, iv) application of robotics and drones in agriculture production and electromagnetic waves in food processing, v) promotion of post-

- harvest technology for fruits and vegetables, and vi) transboundary diseases and health management in agriculture.
- 6. The Meeting agreed to further strengthen and deepen collaboration in the priority areas to address climate change, sustainable agriculture, conservation and nature positive agriculture, climate-resilient agriculture, and sustainable soil management to ensure the sustainability of the agro-ecological system. In this regard, the Meeting welcomed the initiative on the Centrality of Soil in Agriculture and Environment to support the ASEAN Member States (AMS) in reducing the over-fertilization of agriculture through the improvement of soil health and the implementation of smart farming (e.g. soil health card).
- 7. The Meeting agreed to convene the 8<sup>th</sup> ASEAN-India Ministerial Meeting on Agriculture and Forestry in 2024.
- 8. The Meeting expressed its sincere appreciation to the Government of India for the excellent arrangements made for the 7<sup>th</sup> AIMMAF Meeting.
