JOINT PRESS STATEMENT

The 15th ASEAN Directors-General of Immigration Departments and Heads of Consular Affairs Divisions of the Ministries of Foreign Affairs (DGICM) + Australia Consultation

Nay Pyi Taw, Myanmar, 21 August 2019

- 1. The Consultation was co-chaired by U Htay Hlaing, Director General of the Immigration Department of Myanmar and Ms. Peta Maree Dunn, First Assistant Secretary of the Australian Department of Home Affairs.
- 2. The Consultation noted the successful implementation of activities in the ASEAN-Australia Programme of Work 2018-2019 as agreed by the 14th DGICM + Australia Consultation. The Consultation also expressed appreciation for Australia's continued commitment and agreed to pursue a number of practical activities in 2019-2020, demonstrating ASEAN and Australia's shared interests in strengthening immigration capacity across the region.
- 3. Australia shared its experiences regarding the implementation of an Advanced Passenger information (API) system, noting the benefits of closer collaboration between both domestic and regional border and law enforcement agencies.
- 4. The Consultation agreed that the 16th DGICM + Australia Consultation would be held in conjunction with the 24th DGICM in the Philippines in 2020.
